

STRING TREE-SCAPE

Kit Instructions

What's in your kit?

Charger	Sheet of "Snow"	Yarn and decor of your selection
1 sm, 1 med, 1 lg foam tree	Some of these were smooshed a bit in shipping, they are moldable and you can squeeze the tip to make it ... less smooshed.)	
Misc Bag	Contains: Lights, glue, toothpicks, stars, ground decor.	

Instruction	Tips and Tricks
<p>1 Open and unfold yarn.</p>	<p>It shouldn't tangle... but no promises! If it does, just take a deep breath and work through the knots patiently.</p>
<p>2 Glue one end of the yarn to the bottom edge of the cone.</p> <p>You can also apply a thin line of glue to a vertical strip along one side to keep the yarn in place.</p> <p>When you reach the top, glue around the top inch of the cone so the yarn doesn't slip off.</p>	<p>Match the small yarn bag to the small cone!</p> <p>Avoid gluing your yarn over the bottom edge, so your tree stands flat.</p> <p>The glue is one-time-use only and not resealable, so keep it on a paper plate or napkin when you're not using it to avoid spills.</p> <p>No need to cover the whole cone with glue—just enough to keep the yarn in place as you wrap!</p>
<p>3 Wrap the yarn starting at the bottom working your way to the top.</p> <p>When you're done glue the tale where you can cover it with a decoration.</p>	<p>You can wrap the yarn in a straight line up the cone for a clean look or randomly for a more fun look. There's plenty of yarn for both versions.</p>
<p>4 Use the glue to adhere the decor onto your tree.</p> <p>There is enough decor to add to, not cover, the tree.</p>	<p>If this will be displayed where only the front is visible, you will cover more of your tree with decor if you do not decorate the back.</p> <p>Note: If you picked Berries.... guess what! They can become cherries if you hang them upside down! Slip the wires from the berries under the string to hide them and top with a bow!</p>
<p>5 Glue the toothpicks to the back of the stars/signs.</p> <p>The smallest of the stars have holes in them allowing you to thread a toothpick through them.</p>	<p>You will insert the toothpick into the top of the tree. Make sure you push it far enough in that no toothpick shows between the tree and the star.</p> <p>You can use 2 toothpicks for the smallest stars, 2 on one pick, 1 on another and push them in in a V shape, make sure you don't go through the side of your tree though!</p>
<p>6 Arrange the snow on the charger.</p>	<p>Cut the snow to fit inside the small middle circle of the charger or fold the edges under to form a fluffy circle.</p>

		Entirely up to you whether you glue the snow to the charger.
7	Glue the trees and ground decor to the snow.	Gluing the trees to the snow helps ensure they do not fall over. A thin line in the form of an X is sufficient.
8	Wrap the lights around the trees.	<p>There should be enough to wrap all 3 trees or you can drape it on the snow.</p> <p>Do not cut the lights!</p> <p>The lights have 3 modes, fast blink, slow blink, steady.</p> <p>If you have a bag of fake Christmas lights as well, there is enough to wrap around 1-2 of your trees, not all 3.</p>
